Limited Income Assistance for Water and/or Wastewater Construction Charge

Dear Coburg Resident,

The City of Coburg Ordinance A-224.11.8.3 provides rate reduction assistance for some low-income residential users.

You must re/enroll to reduce your rate each fiscal year as household income and the City's available resources to support the program change from year to year.

To apply:

1. Submit a *Limited Income Assistance Application* to the City. Applications are available at City Hall or can be sent to you via email.
2. Provide proof of identification and annual household income. A current 1040 tax form is the suggested supporting documentation.

See if you are eligible on the back of this page.

Applications must be received by the City by September 7, 2012 otherwise you will not receive any assistance (through July 2013). If eligible, assistance will be applied to your September 2012 utility bill. If you currently receive assistance and do not reenroll, your water and wastewater rate assistance will return to the base rate. You will not be eligible to receive assistance again until next year.

The City accepts and appreciates donations to the Limited Income Assistance program at any time.

EXAMPLE: A household of four (4) that makes \$30,000 gross annual income would pay \$44 per month for wastewater construction charge plus the basic water rate.
