**May 1-June 30, 2013**  
**Limited Income Assistance for Water and/or Wastewater Utility Bills**

Dear Coburg Resident,

The City of Coburg Ordinance A-224.11. provides rate reduction method to assist some limited income residential users.

Residential utility users **must reenroll each fiscal year (by June 30<sup>th</sup>)** as household income and the City's available resources to support the program change annually.

To apply:

1. Submit a *Limited Income Assistance Application*.
2. Provide proof of identification and annual household income by completing an *Income Verification Form*.

Both forms are available at City Hall or from the City website [www.coburgoregon.org](http://www.coburgoregon.org). See if you are eligible on the back of this page.

In order to qualify for this program for the new fiscal year, **applications must be received between May 1<sup>st</sup> and June 30<sup>th</sup> 2013**. Because the wastewater system is being built now, this year's change to your assistance level will be applied to the utility bill the month following your property's hook-up to the wastewater system. Until then, you will continue to receive the same assistance as you do now (if you are a current participant). Any current participant who does not reenroll by June 30<sup>th</sup> will not continue to receive the assistance after July 2013 utility bill.

The City accepts and appreciates donations to the Limited Income Assistance program at any time. Your entire donation will be directed toward assisting a limited income resident.

**Water Eligibility:**

You qualify if your annual gross household income is less than or equal to \$9,000.

**Wastewater Construction Charge Eligibility:**

EXAMPLE: A household of four (4) that makes \$30,000 gross annual income would pay \$67 per month for wastewater plus the basic water rate.
