What Will 'Hook-Up' Look Like?



Phase 4 of the Coburg Wastewater Project begins Spring 2013. Phase 4 is the connection from your septic tank(s) to the wastewater treatment plant. Above and Below: Typical finished appearance of tanks (green lids).



The Coburg Wastewater Project has entered the final phase!

- The collection system (pipes and vaults) have all been placed and the Treatment Facility complete
- The first hook-up for wastewater service begins in April 2013
- A Wastewater Operator has been hired. His name is Timothy Sanders.
- A contractor for the hook-up has been selected

In January, the City provided you policies that will guide the hook-up process. The aim is to create clear guidelines and expectations for both the City and property owners before work starts. We want everyone to be ready for the work on your property will include installing pipes from the street to your tank, and – in some cases – installing a new tank.

It will also include an electrical connection from the pump in the tank to your house or business.

As early as **May** for some businesses and **June-October** for residents; the hook-ups will be completed.
