**Congratulations Coburg!** The Wastewater Project has moved past the halfway mark. Thank you all for your cooperation and support thus far. At this time:

- The collection system (pipes and vaults) have all been placed
- The Wastewater Treatment Facility will be completed by February
- The first hook-up for wastewater service should be in April 2013
- A Wastewater Operator will be hired in February
- A contractor will be selected in February

The City continues to plan for the final steps.

One of the important next steps is the inspection of each of the existing septic tanks and the installation of new systems on private property to collect the wastewater and send it to the treatment plant.






## Phase 4 is the ‘hook-up’

## from the street to your tank

As early as **May** for some businesses and **June** for some residents, the hook-up will be completed. Enclosed with this update are **policies** that will govern the installation of the rest of the system, and what the City will do under certain circumstances. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with this. It sets expectations for how you may or may not be impacted by this year’s work.

- What happens if my electrical panel is full?
- What happens if hazardous waste is found on my property around my tank?
- How will I be noticed before work starts on my property?
- What is the City paying for?
- Will my landscaping be replaced?

These and many more questions will be answered in the policy document.
