## Trench Patching 2012

### **What is a trench patch?**

A trench patch - or trench paving - is the asphalt that covers the hole where the wastewater pipe is placed in the street.

### **Is the trench patching finished?**

No. If the pipe construction has come down your street, the trench patch is most likely temporary. Another, smoother and harder permanent patch will be applied by the end of August 2012.

### **Why is there a temporary patch?**

Due to all of the heavy equipment on the streets, the City contracted to wait until almost all of the work in the right-of-way for this phase (Phase II - Collection System) was complete before placing the final patch application.

### **Will the existing streets be completely repaved?**

No. Repaving the streets was not in the Wastewater Project scope.
