<u>City Council:</u> The City of Council is composed of six Councilors that serve four-year terms. City Council is governing body with legislative, administrative and quasi-judicial authority. These authorities are exercised through adopting ordinances, approving resolutions and approving orders.

<u>Meetings</u>: City Council meets regularly the second Tuesday of each month and the fourth Tuesday as needed. Councilors are also part of the Budget Committee which meets 3-6 times per year. Special meetings are also scheduled as needed.

<u>Membership:</u> City Council shall be composed of six Councilors nominated and elected from the City at large, except that when one or more vacancies exist on the City Council, it shall be deemed to be composed of those persons actually then holding the Office of Councilor.

Vacancies: One (1)

Term: This is a partial term that expires December 31, 2024.

<u>Membership Requirements:</u> Applicants must be qualified electors under state law, and reside within the City for at least one year immediately before election or appointment to office.

<u>Application Deadline:</u> Applications are due by 5:00 pm, Friday, June 28, 2024; however, that date may be extended at Councils discretion if not filled.
