The City of Coburg is seeking applications from citizens interested in serving on the Historic Preservation Commission.

Coburg Historic Preservation Commission

This committee was formed in 1979. It is currently operating under Ordinance A-226 and the Coburg Comprehensive Plan. Council established this committee as an advisory body to the Planning Commission Except for provisions listed in the Ordinance A-226 under Section 5.

The purpose of this committee is to identify, recognize, and preserve significant properties related to the community's history; encourage the rehabilitation and ongoing viability of historic buildings and structures; strengthen public support for historic preservation efforts within the community; foster civic pride; and encourage cultural heritage tourism. Council has assigned this committee specific duties that are listed in Ordinance A-226 under Section 6.

Meetings: Currently meeting 1 time per month (at least 4 meetings per year).

Vacancies: One (1) to Three (3)

Membership Requirements:

Three but no more than five members with a demonstrated competence, knowledge, or interest in historic preservation with preference given to those with professional experience in the fields of preservation, architecture, archaeology, community history, building trades, real estate, or related specialties. At least two members shall consist of one Planning Commissioner, and one resident of the City of Coburg. In cases where there is not sufficient interest or it is difficult to find qualified members it is acceptable to select commissioners from outside the City of Coburg. Members shall serve without compensation, but are eligible for reimbursement of expenses related to their service. At least one member of the Commission shall reside within the Coburg Historic District.
